

ATLAS AGREEMENT No. 525/2013

Physics Content and Platform Support for ATLAS Outreach

BETWEEN

The ATLAS Collaboration

Represented by the Resources Coordinator on the one hand,

AND

US-ATLAS,

Represented by the US ATLAS Project Manager,

On the other hand

CONSIDERING THAT:

- The US has signed the ATLAS M&O MoU (CERN-RRB-2002-035);
- The M&O-A has a budget line for Outreach, Communication and Collaborative Tools;
- ATLAS Institutes are encouraged to offer their expertise in outreach activities to help the public understand the importance of ATLAS during its lifetime;
- ATLAS has drafted an outreach plan with defined work packages, endorsed by the Management;
- US ATLAS has the expertise available to offer for ATLAS;

IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:**ARTICLE 1 SCOPE OF THE AGREEMENT**

- 1.1 The purpose of the Agreement is to record the specified tasks and financial arrangement related to work packages for outreach. These tasks are described in separate Addenda attached to the present Agreement.

ARTICLE 2 OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES

- 2.1 US ATLAS channels expertise in the domain of educational application development, exhibit preparation, and communication support. This effort is recognized at six person-months.
- 2.2 US ATLAS will support personnel either at CERN or in the US to execute the agreed work packages. The personnel dispatched to CERN will at all times, while on CERN premises, adhere to the CERN and ATLAS safety rules and regulations which form an integral part of this document. After the work package(s) is completed, the personnel will leave the CERN premises.
- 2.3 ATLAS shall provide adequate facilities for US ATLAS members to work at CERN for these specific assignments.

ARTICLE 3 FUNDING

- 3.1 US ATLAS will be reimbursed in accordance with the work executed and reported to the ATLAS Outreach Coordinator(s). The recognized value is 4128 CHF per person-month. The total amount of 24,768 CHF for the period from Nov. 1st 2013 to April 30 2014 will be paid from T575110 to the US-ATLAS Team account T541500.

ARTICLE 4 DURATION OF THE AGREEMENT

- 4.1 This Agreement shall be in force until 30 April 2014. The Agreement can be extended by mutual consent through an appropriate Addendum.

ARTICLE 6 ARBITRATION




